

## Missions Pastor

International Baptist Church (IBC), Singapore

IBC is God's home for the nations that seek to unite all people in Christ in love by making disciples for the glory of God. This is our vision and we hope that you will help lead us and be part of this journey with us in the role of Missions Pastor. The Missions Pastor serves as the primary disciple maker for the church's international and local outreach efforts. This person is responsible for aligning the church's resources (financial, human and spiritual) with the Great Commission, making disciples of all nations. The Missions Pastor will report to the Senior Pastor of IBC and work closely with the IBC Missions board.

### What you will be doing (essential duties)

- Strategic leadership - Create and lead the processes of sending out full time missionaries, and executing the existing long term vision for missions that aligns with the overall church vision.
- Partnership management - Humility to connect with the lay country leaders and IBC missions board. Provide care support of the missionaries that IBC sends out (long-term and short-term), IBC-supported missions organizations and International and local Missionary agencies, ensuring collaboration, accountability and mutual support.
- Local Missions Development - Rolling out of local missions programs that engage the Singapore community and provide members with opportunities to serve meaningfully in Singapore.
- Training & equipping – Create pathways for interested members to discern their missional calling, providing training for short term missions and long term vocational missions.
- Ministry Coordination - Collaborate with other IBC ministries to integrate missions activities across the life of the church.
- Congregational engagement - Inspire/mobilize the congregation toward active participation in missions.
- Portfolio Growth - Strengthen and expand IBC's missions portfolio (currently spanning 10 nations), ensuring sustainable growth year after year.
- Budgetary oversight – Manage missions-related budgets in collaboration with the Missions Board, ensuring faithful stewardship and financial accountability.

### What qualifications and experience you bring

- A heart for mission.
- Good at building relationships across generations, including young adults, in order to prepare and expose them to missions.
- Master of Divinity or a Masters in Missiology/Intercultural studies preferred, or a theological degree.
- Able to travel on a flexible passport, especially in the SEA region.
- Gifted in communication and teaching.
- Self-motivated, have a teachable spirit to grow as a person and as a leader. A strong team player among fellow staff, working together to strengthen all areas of the church's ministry, having the proven ability to involve others in planning and decision-making.
- A minimum of 5-years undertaking missions.
- Experience with ministering in an international congregational context, with multi-lingual skills an asset.

### What you will need to succeed here

- Desire to do missions, a heart to grow missions.
- Have been on multiple mission trips.
- Ensure a steady increase in percentage of the IBC members who are actively serving on regional and local missions.
- Financial accountability and integrity.
- Willing to work within the IBC missions framework.
