1. Following Jesus leads us to see the priority of the need (3:1-6)
 - a. Pharisees focus on outward obedience of the sabbath (3:2-5)
 - i. Watching vs. worshipping
 - ii. Hardness of heart vs. heart for the hurting (3:5)
 - b. Jesus focuses on the person in need (3:1,3-5)
 - i. To heal is to give life (3:4)
 - ii. The Healer is life (3:5)
 - iii. The Healer is the Lord of the Sabbath (2:28; 3:5)
2. Following Jesus leads us to ministry (3:7-19)
 - a. Commences with a relational foundation (3:7a,13-14, 6-19)
 - b. Continues with ministry overflow (3)
 - i. The Sending (3:14-15)
 - ii. The Scope (3:8-12)
 1. To the human hurt (3:8-10)
 2. Demonic domain (3:11-12)
