1. Jewish leaders interrogate Jesus based on their own narrative (11:27–33)
  - a. Initial question (11:28)
  - b. Counter question (11:29–30)
  - c. Religious dilemma (11:31–33a)
    - i. From heaven
    - ii. From men
  - d. Cowardly comeback (11:33)
2. Jesus graciously invites us into His narrative (12:1–12)
  - a. The Old Testament Narrative – love relationship between Yahweh and Israel (12:1–9)
    - i. God's plan for His people (12:1–2)
    - ii. God's pursuit of His people (12:3–6)
    - iii. Israel rejects God (12:3–8) Lev 19:23–25
    - iv. God responds in judgement (12:9)
  - b. The New Testament Narrative (12:10–12)

1. Describe a recent experience or event when you invited Jesus to speak His wisdom, will, and love into your narrative? What changed?
2. What is the one area in your narrative today where you would welcome His voice, presence, and wisdom? Pray now that He would replace your narrative with His.
