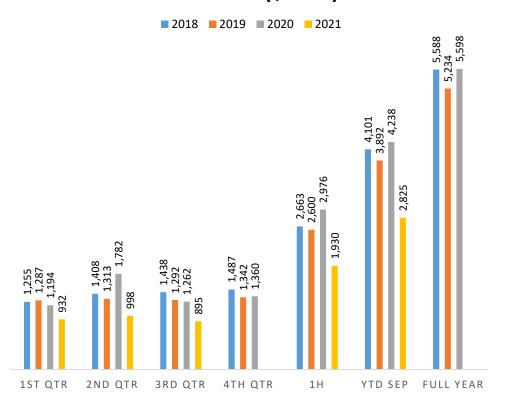


2021 YTD September Financial Report

YTD Sep 2021 Summary - Receipts

RECEIPTS (\$'000)

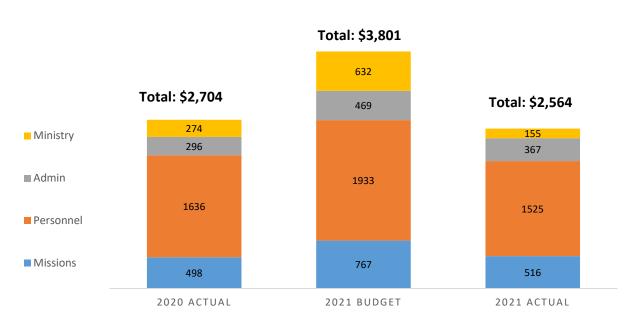
- YTD Sep receipts of \$2.83m are 34% lower year-on-year.
- Receipts include designated gifts of \$123.3k, compared with \$181.6k in 2020.
- There were also significant one-time gifts in 2nd Qtr 2020 which were not repeated this year.



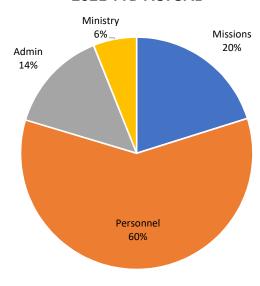
YTD Sep 2021 Summary – Cash Expenses

- YTD 2021 actual cash expenses of \$2.56m are 8% lower than 2020 actual & 33% lower than 2021 budget.
- Missions and Personnel contribute 20% and 60% of total expenses, and all ministries are below budget from reduced activities due to the pandemic situation.

YTD Sept 2021 Summary - Cash

- We had positive YTD Sep cash flow of \$110.8k as the decrease in expenses exceeded receipts.
- Cash balance at end of Sep 2021 was \$7.8 million.
- Available cash net of commitments was \$6.2 million (\$6.0 million at end-2020).
- Capex at \$27.6k was only 4.1% of full year budget as most planned projects were delayed due to the pandemic situation.

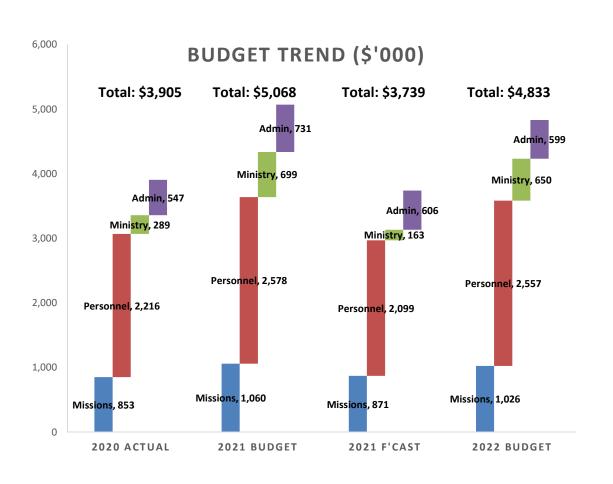


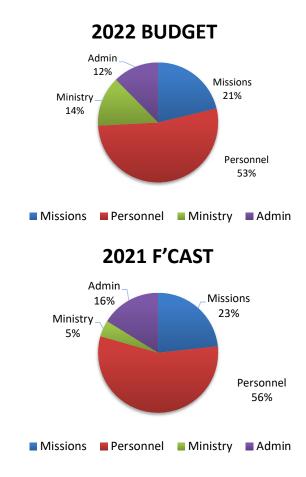
Proposed 2022 Budget

2022 Budget Assumptions

- Singapore transitions to COVID-19 endemic phase in 2022 with easing of precautionary measures.
- IBC's focus will be on church-wide activities, and we will increase the number of activities in 2022.
- However, limits on group sizes, Safe-Distancing Measures and wearing of masks will still be practiced.
- On-site & on-line services will continue.
- Travel restrictions will ease but travel for missions will not be encouraged.

2021 Forecast – Cash Expenses

- Most church activities remain suspended due to the COVID-19 safe management measures (SMMs)
- Cash expenses are forecasted to be \$3.74m, which is 23.3% below budget and 2.2% lower than 2020 Actual:
 - Significantly lower Ministry and Admin expenses expected (76.6% and 17.2% respectively) as planned activities did not occur
 - Personnel expenses will be 8.6% below budget because planned hires were not achieved
 - Mission expense will be 17.8% lower as budgets for disaster relief and other global missions not utilised
 - Compared to 2020, Ministry and Personnel are expected to be 43.4% and 5.3% lower respectively, offset by Admin and Missions expenses each higher by 10.6%

2022 Budget – Cash Expenses

- Cash Expenses are budgetted to be \$4.83m, which is 4.6% lower than the 2021 budget and 29.3% more than what we forecast for 2021:
 - Personnel Increase by 21.8% against 2021 forecast due to added headcount needs, costs associated with on-boarding new staff and higher salaries.
 - Missions Excluding designated gifts, 3.6% lower than 2021 budget mainly from reduced funding for organizations.
 - Admin 1.0% lower than 2021 forecast due to lower consultancy fees, offset by increased maintenance, operational expenses for more activities, and inflation.
 - Ministry 4x higher than 2021 forecast due to higher participation from increased activities.

HEADCOUNT & EXPENSE TREND (\$ '000)



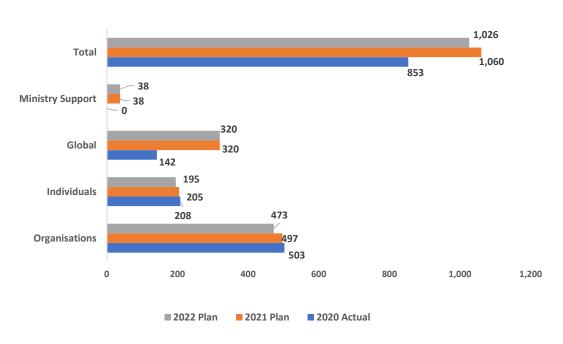

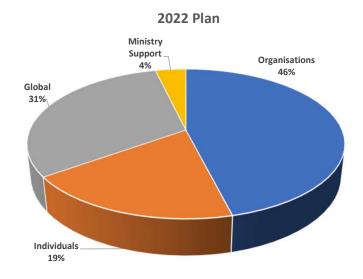

2022 Budget - Capital Expenditure

2021 Forecast

- Most planned capital expenditures did not proceed due to COVID-19
- Key projects executed were the installation of a retractable awning at the Queen's Road entrance and upgrading of the sanctuary digital audio mixer
- Full year forecast is about \$100k, which is 14.8% of the full year budget

2022 Budget

- Plan of \$831.2k is 22.7% higher than the 2021 budget, as some deferred projects from the last 2 years will be carried out
- Major projects to maintain the church building and upgrade equipment:
 - Building repair & painting work \$280k
 - Sanctuary Sound System replacement & upgrade \$250k
 - o IT Systems hardware and software upgrades \$55k
 - Sanctuary secondary aircon replacement \$50k
 - Replacement of Sanctuary projectors & screens \$45k
 - Relocation of fire alarm panel \$40k
 - Security System additions & upgrades \$30k
